ABOUT THE VIPA AIRPORTS P3 INDUSTRY FORUM

The Virgin Islands Port Authority (VIPA) continues to move forward with its plans to pursue a public/private partnership (P3) arrangement with a private airport investor, operator, and terminal developer to modernize and upgrade the Henry E. Rohlsen Airport (STX) on St. Croix and the Cyril E. King Airport (STT) on St. Thomas, United States Virgin Islands.

VIPA issued a Request for Qualifications on December 29, 2022, seeking airport operators, developers, and infrastructure investors for the project. Airport P3 participants were invited to an industry forum where USVI and VIPA officials will provide information about the territory and both airports.

More than 35 firms and over 90 people representing airport operators, terminal developers, investment banks, architects, contractors, and consultants registered to attend the forum.
